

Position Description: Director of Language Acquisition

The Superior General and General Council appoint the Director of Language Acquisition. The Director of Language Acquisition reports directly to the General Council.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. The Director will oversee the Basilian Language Acquisition Program which will facilitate scholastics and recently ordained Basilians living in a Basilian house in another country in order to increase their proficiency in Spanish or English.
- 2. To coordinate with the Formation Committees in each country which Basilians will be studying Spanish or English in another country and for what period of time.
- 3. To maintain an ongoing list of language schools, personal tutors and programs that are proximate to Basilian houses and to coordinate with the local Basilian superior appropriate ministries when applicable.
- 4. To support the language acquisition and cultural assimilation of participants by listening and providing feedback to their experiences, frustrations and successes.
- 5. To evaluate and monitor the effectiveness of the language school, tutor, participant, Basilian house and ministry after every program is completed.

EXPERIENCES, SKILLS AND STYLES REQUIRED

- 1. An appreciation for and experiences of Basilian life and ministry.
- 2. Commitment to prayer and personal on-going formation and professional development.
- 3. Spoken and written capabilities in both English and Spanish.
- 4. An empathy for the challenges faced in learning a language and living in another culture.
- 5. Ability to maintain a database of preferred language programs and tutors.
